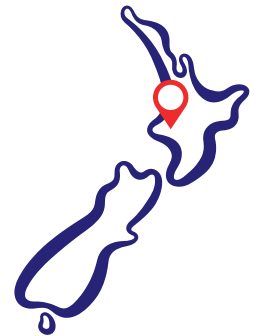




CULLINANE COLLEGE
