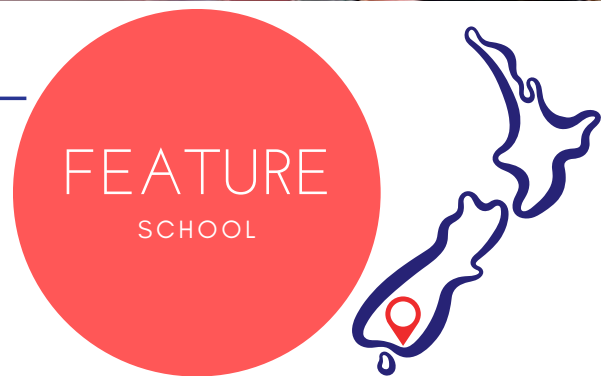

International students are encouraged to become fully immersed in the life of the school.
