

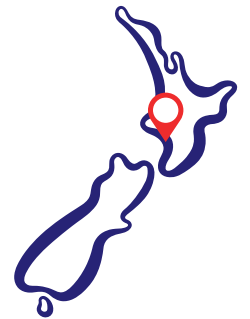


# MANAWATU COLLEGE
