Aldergrove Community Secondary School is a part of the Langley School District and resides on the traditional and unceded territories of the Kwantlen, Katzie, Matsqui, and Semiahmoo First Nations. Their enrolment includes 600 full-time students including 140 international students. The school hosts a variety of programs designed to meet diverse student needs including Advancement via Individual Determination (AVID), fine arts and applied skills programs, and an alternate education program. ACSS also offers Industrial Training Authority sponsored Youth Train in Trades Automotive Service Technician, Carpentry, and Hairdressing dual credit programs.

Aldergrove is located at the southeastern edge of both the Township of Langley and the Greater Vancouver metropolitan area. It is home to one of the Lower Mainland's five land border crossings, connecting Aldergrove and Lynden, Washington. Students can enjoy the nearby Greater Vancouver Zoo and the Twilight Drive-in Theatre. The Aldergrove Credit Union Community Centre opened in 2018, with an accompanying Outdoor Experience water park, featuring water slides, a wave pool, lazy river and an aquaplay structure. The community centre includes a fitness centre, ice rink, pools, and a waterpark.
